

FINAL EXAM SCHEDULES AND INFORMATION

Pittsburgh Campus – Spring Term 2026 Final Exam Schedule Information

The final exam period for daytime undergraduate classes for the Spring Term begins on Monday, April 27, 2026, and ends on Friday, May 1, 2026. All undergraduate courses follow the exam schedule outlined below. Graduate, College of General Studies, Saturday and evening classes (starting at 6 p.m. or later) will have final exams during the last schedule meeting the week of finals.

There are two types of exams: departmental and hourly. Departmental exams are used primarily for large classes or multiple sections giving a common exam. All departmental exams are scheduled in the 8 AM time block Monday through Friday shown in the grid below. Courses not identified in the departmental exam schedule should follow the hourly exam schedule, which is determined by the day(s) and time the class is scheduled during the term.

Hourly exams are based on the regular meeting time of the class. A class starting at or within the hour should utilize the hourly exam block associated with that time. For example, a class that met on Tuesday and Thursday at 9:00 or 9:30 a.m. would utilize the Tuesday, 9:00 a.m. hourly exam time. The schedule indicates that the final exam will be given on Wednesday, from 12:00 p.m. to 1:50 p.m. Courses that meet only on Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, are not specifically covered in the exam schedule. Final exams for these classes are given during the Monday or Tuesday class period. For example, Thursday follows Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday follows Monday. The final exam grid is shown below. Please note that the final exam may be scheduled in a different room than the class was held.

- Final exams are to be given during the designated final exam time. Only in extenuating circumstances, with approval from the dean, and the Office of the University Registrar, will a final exam date or time be changed.
