Criminalistics: An Introduction to Forensic Science, uses clear writing, my personal case stories, and modern technology to capture the pulse and fervor of forensic science investigations. Originally designed for with no scientific background, only the most relevant scientific and technological concepts are presented. The nature of physical evidence is defined, and the limitations that technology and current knowledge impose on its individualization and characterization are examined. A major portion of the course centers on discussions of the common items of physical evidence encountered at crime scenes. Particular attention is paid to the meaning and role of probability in interpreting the evidential significance of scientifically evaluated evidence.

We will also look at when a person confronted with a government investigation and/or prosecution is, and when she is not, entitled to the assistance of counsel. We will not only study the relevant legal concepts; we will also apply them to a variety of situations in a variety of ways, practice searching and seizing, and write search warrant applications.
